| Bellamico Campania, Italy
Fresh, lush and lively white wine that compares well to a Pinot Grigio.
It carries aromas and flavours of green apples and citrus fruits along with honey and almond. | | | |
| 4. SEMILLON CHARDONNAY | £3.65 | £4.95 | £14.30 |
| Barren Jack, South Eastern Australia
An elegant wine with a palate rich in the apple and citrus flavours of the Semillon and the peach and dried fig characters of the Chardonnay. | | | |
| 5. CORTESE ★ | £3.85 | £5.35 | £15.35 |
| Colle dei Tigli, Veneto, Italy
Made on an ancient hill (Colle) covered with lime trees (Tigli), on the eastern shores of Lake Garda. Light straw-yellow, fruity intense aroma, with hints of peach and apple with a delicate bouquet of flowers. | | | |
| 6. ORVIETO | | | £15.35 |
| Coli Vineyard, Umbria, Italy
Taking its name from the fortified town of Orvieto, giving delicate floral hints of acacia, lime blossom, ripe apple and toasted bread. | | | |
| 7. SAUVIGNON BLANC ★ | | | £19.45 |
| Mission Estate, Marlborough, New Zealand
Established in 1851 by the French Marist religious order, Mission Estate Winery is New Zealand's oldest winemaker. The ripe bouquet is of tropical fruit, citrus, passionfruit and gooseberry. | | | |
| 8. CHABLIS ★ | | | £20.45 |
| Domaine Tremblay, Burgundy, France
A classic Chardonnay wine. Superb, refreshing, clean dry white wine from the medal winning producer Gérard Tremblay (Highly recommended producer in the Decanter August 2007). | | | |

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| 9. GARNACHA TINTA | £3.20 | £4.45 | £12.85 |
| Vega Roble Castilla, Spain
A young fruity rosé with aromas of strawberry and touches of sweet jasmine.
Crisp citrus and soft cherry flavours. | | | |
| 10. PINOT GRIGIO ROSATO | £3.50 | £4.90 | £14.30 |
| Rocca Estate, Italy
A brilliant pink colour with a delicate and floral aroma. It has a subtle and fresh taste that is well suited to salads and white meats. | | | |

| Mission Estate, Hawkes Bay, New Zealand
The wine has a lovely pink hue and the ripe flavours from good vineyard sites.

| Barren Jack, South Eastern Australia
An artful blend of the vibrant Shiraz and the classic elegance of the Cabernet.

| 13. SANGIOVESE/MERLOT ★ | £3.85 | £5.35 | £15.35 |
| Colle Forte Veneto, Italy
A wine with its own distinct personality. Intense ruby red, fragrant and intense, with hints of berries. Full-bodied, velvety and harmonious. | | | |
| 14. MALBEC/SYRAH | | | £16.35 |
| Magallanes, Argentina
Fine and elegant nose, a perfect mix of red fruits and spices. Sweet mouth, with tannins of great quality contributing an unique structure. | | | |

| Blason de Esquide, Fuenmayor, Spain
Aged for one year in American oak casks, and a further six months in bottles.
This results in a rich ruby red colour, a gentle aroma and a long finish which is pleasing to the mouth. | | | |

| Hugo Casanova, Chile
A superb example of this classic grape variety. Well-structured and balanced with elegant persistence and a touch of vanilla and oak. A "Gem" of a wine! | | | |

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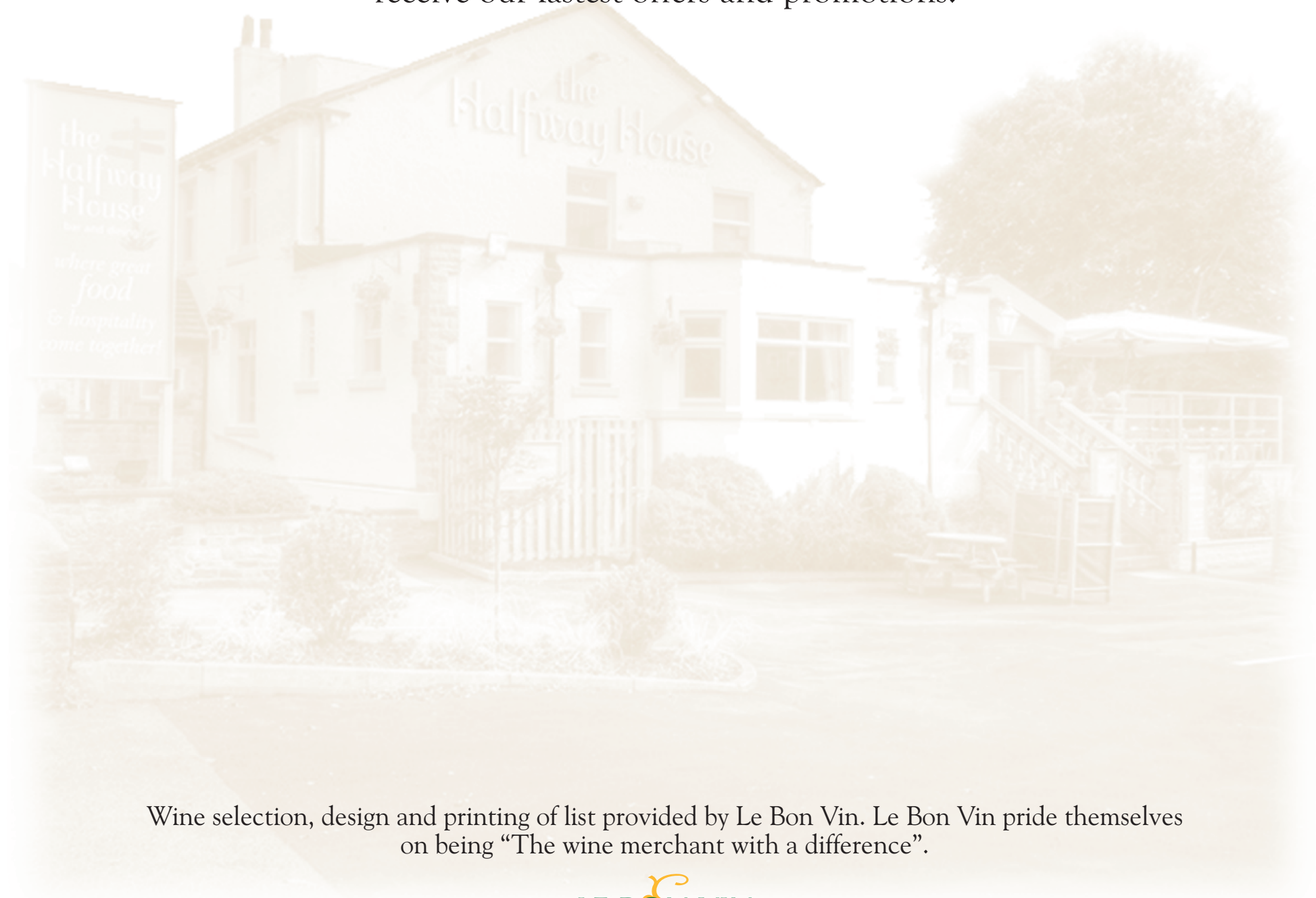
